Recognizes and names all upper- and lowercase letters	
Produces the correct sound for all letters	
Counts, pronounces, blends and segment syllables in spoken words	
Isolates initial, medial vowel, and final sounds in words	
Blends sounds to form words	
Substitutes sounds to form new words	
Produces long and short sound for each of the five vowels: a, e, i, o, u	
Reads grade-appropriate sight words	
Reads beginning level texts

Prints all upper-and lowercase letters legibly (using lines and spaces):	
Prints first and last name legibly (using lines and spaces)	
Writes correct letter when given a sound	
Spells simple words phonetically	
Recognizes and names end punctuation marks	
Correctly writes a complete sentence (capital letter, spaces, end punctuation)	
Understands and uses questions words (who, what, when, where, why, how)	
Communicates messages (i.e. writes, draws, dictates) for a variety of purposes:

Counting and Cardinality	
Rote counts to 100 by ones	
Counts to 100 by tens	
Counts forward correctly beginning at any given number	
Reads and orders numbers 0-20	
Counts objects up to 20 (1:1 correspondence)	
Writes numerals 0-20	
Writes numerals to represent sets of 0-20	
Numbers & Operations in Base Ten	
Composes numbers 11-19 using a ten and further ones	
Decomposes numbers 11-19 into a ten and further ones	
Represents base ten compositions/decompositions with an equation (ex. $10+8=18$)	
Operations & Algebraic Thinking	
Uses objects or drawings to represent addition word problems within 10	
Uses objects or drawings to represent subtraction word problems within 10	
Decomposes numbers up to 10 into pairs in more than one way	
Given a number 1-9, finds the number that makes 10	
Fluently adds within 5	
Fluently subtracts within 5

Identifies and describes 3-D shapes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • cubes • cones • spheres • cylinders 	
Identifies shapes as two-dimensional or three-dimensional	
Draws and builds 2-D and 3-D shapes
